2024 Flower Show Requirements

- **All classes are open to amateur growers**
- **More than one entry is allowed per class. On the condition, that the entries are different (cultivar, type and color). Only 10 entries are allowed per exhibition.**
- **Clear small mouthed containers are permitted such as recycled plastic water bottles or glass vases.**
- **Only one stem per container is permitted (Calla Lily can have 2 stem). Using multiple blooms is optional**
- **Foil or plastic wrap can be used to prop the stem. Wiring can be used for the vines only.**
- **All specimens must be labeled in waterproof with the entry slip**
- **Specimens (except for Pansies and Calla Lilies) must contain at least one leaf.**
- **Oiling or spraying flowers and using artificial colors is forbidden**
- **Water must not contain leaves or roots**

Tips For Preparing Your Entry

- **Select your fully developed bloom/specimen**
- **Cut the stem in a room temperature environment**
- **Place the plant in the water**
- **Trim the stem while it is in the water**
- **Leave the specimen in the water overnight**
- **Before the flower show, place the specimen in a clear small mouthed container with clear water in it**
- **Make sure that the water covers the end of the stem**
- **Remove any old blooms and old or damaged leaves**
- **Trim the stem so that the container is 2/3 of the height of the specimen**
- **Do not cut the anthers of the Lilies.**
- **Daylilies can be trimmed a day before the show for the best stability.**
- **Use recycled soda cup holders or inverted boxes with a cut out X to keep the plant stable when driving to the Flower Show**
